Dear Walbrook Members

The Committee met last night and confirm that there will be no rowing during lockdown in accordance with BR's statement:

*Crews made up of a single household (including [Support Bubbles](#)) are permitted to row, subject to any local navigation authorities, where no access to club property is required for this to safely take place. For the avoidance of doubt, this means you can't access boats and equipment stored in club boathouses or on racks/trailers on club property and you cannot use club-owned landing stages.*

The Club equipment will therefore be "laid up" with the insurers. TWC has indicated that anyone wishing to remove their boat from the site in order to scull elsewhere must do so by 12 noon Saturday

The Committee would like to support Club members who would like to continue their training and borrow an ergo as we did in the last Lockdown on the strict understanding that it will need to be returned immediately Lockdown ends. If you would like to enter the ballot then please let me know by Saturday morning (7/11) by 10am so that I can then advise collection time on Saturday afternoon There will be 7 ergos for adults and 7 for juniors.
